

## Comment sought on plans

Mundaring Shire residents will get the chance to have their say on the Parkerville and Stoneville developments when the structure plans are advertised for public comment.

Stoneville Progress Association Vice Chairman, Rusty Geller, sought clarification of any advertis-

ing plans at last week's council meeting, following a letter from the Department for Planning and Infrastructure.

The SPA received a letter in May that stated modifications to the structural plans were likely to be advertised for public comment.

Mr Geller also said the

association had received another letter from the Minister's Parliamentary Secretary, Adele Farina, this year which listed five issues that needed to be resolved in the plans before the development's land could be transferred from Urban Deferred zone to Urban zone.

The points listed included

urbanisation of the areas must be a logical extension of the urban development, environmental issues must be addressed, and that there was sufficient infrastructure capacity and an employment strategy.

The shire said clarification would be sought on the matter.
