Technical Advisory Committee Minutes June

3a. Request to Site a Waste Water / Effluent Treatment Plant at the Red Hill Waste Management Facility (Item 9.1)

Overview

- A request to locate a plant to treat waste water and effluent at Red Hill has been received from the Stoneville and Parkerville developments' Town Planning Consultants.
- A treatment plant is required for the developments proposed for Parkerville and Stoneville to proceed.
- There is a large development proposed for the Gidgegannup townsite that may also require the provision of a sewage treatment plant.
- The development of Red Hill requires there to be a reliable source of water for operations and the treated water from the proposed plant could satisfy that need.

Resolution(s)

- That the EMRC officers undertake a detailed investigation into the proposal to locate a sewage treatment facility within the Red Hill Waste Management Facility site and report back to Council at a future date.

Implication(s) for Shire of Mundaring

- Allows for additional development in Parkerville and Stoneville.
