## Proposed dense urbanisation of the Hills

We are not against development per se, however, we are adamant that any development and services related to it should be of an appropriate and sustainable kind.

We have great concern with the environmental problems related to sewage disposal. We are also extremely troubled by the social and public health issues that these developments would generate.

Our rapidly growing membership is anxious to know how the Water Corporation plans to treat sewage in these proposed developments. We are getting so many different stories about how the Water Authority intends to do this, so we would very much like to hear from you what the official position is. Our next meeting is on Wednesday August 17<sup>th</sup> and I would like to be able to relate your response to these questions to our members at this time.
