Dear Mayor, Councillors & CEO,

Re: Proposed 140 ha. expansion of Hanson's Redhill Quarry

I am writing on behalf of residents of Mundaring Shire who have contacted our organisation regarding their concerns over the lack of consultation afforded to them re the above proposal.

The impacts of such a development would have major consequences for many people who are not residents of your Shire, but live nearby, and whose quality of life and environment would be directly impacted. I recall when I first moved to Stoneville being concerned that we were experiencing earthquake tremors. I was told that this was caused by explosions from Redhill Quarry. Residents of Parkerville also have to live with noise from the quarry, explosions and tremors.

We are campaigning for more effective legal protection for the Hills from inappropriate or unsustainable development – protection that would ensure that development in one Shire could not proceed without the approval of those directly affected in any adjacent Shire. This will be presented to Parliament as a Green Bill in the coming months.

We are all acutely aware that we now live in a world where the actions of each and every one of us impacts on many other people. I would ask you therefore to consult fully with all those affected by your proposals, even if they are not resident within your boundaries.
